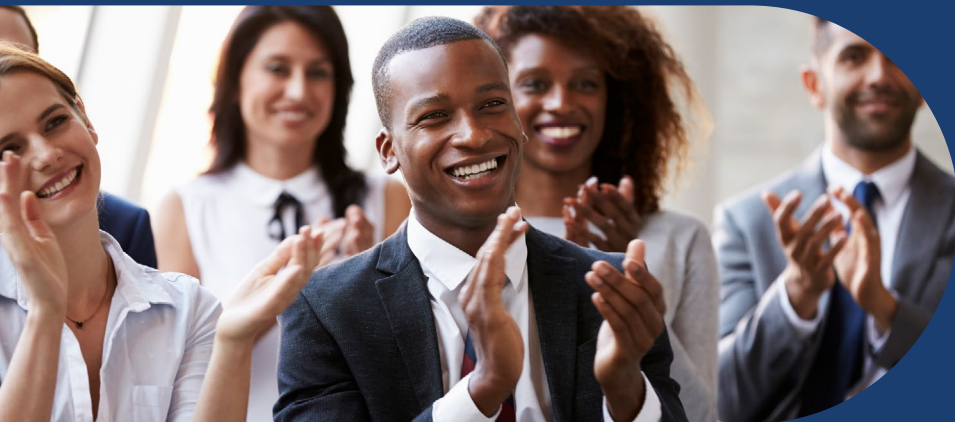
## IMAC AND THE COMMUNITY
